Bath Elementary School Intervention Program Description

First Grade

During the 2015-16 school-year, Bath Elementary School first grade students will receive reading and math interventions from the intervention team and grade-level teachers. During a 25- to 40-minute time period that has been set aside specifically for interventions, students will remain in their classrooms or "walk-to" an intervention, led by either a grade level teacher or interventionist. In this model, students have the opportunity to receive additional instruction specific to their learning needs.

Student placements have been determined by beginning-of-the-year school-wide and classroom assessments. If your student is receiving interventions from an intervention team member for the first time, you will receive a phone call prior to the start of "walk-to's." In addition, all students will receive an agreement for parents/guardians to sign. Intervention groups will change throughout the year, as students acquire necessary skills and move into other groups. If you would like additional information, please contact your child's teacher.

2nd - 5th Grades

During the 2015-16 school-year, Bath Elementary School will continue to use a "Walk-To" model for providing interventions to our students. Through this model, students will receive reading and math interventions from the intervention team and grade-level teachers. During a 25- to 40-minute time period each day that has been set aside specifically for interventions, students in grades two through five will "walk-to" an intervention, led by either a grade level teacher or interventionist. In this model, students have the opportunity to receive additional instruction specific to their learning needs, including those above grade-level.

Student placements have been determined by beginning-of-the-year school-wide and classroom assessments. If your child received interventions from the intervention team last year, that will continue unless you have received an exit or discontinue letter. If your student is receiving interventions from an intervention team member for the first time, you will receive a phone call prior to the start of "walk-to's." In addition, all former and new students will receive an agreement for parents/guardians to sign. Intervention groups will change throughout the year, as students acquire necessary skills and move into other groups. If you would like additional information, please contact your child's teacher.
