Thrun and NEOLA are both ecommending that we move forward adopting the policy. None of the rulings hat have come out so far change the federal requirement for us to adopt this policy by August 1 st . Policy 2264 is the NEOLA policy that meets the equirements of the new title IX regulations. Policy 2266 is our current Title IX policy and is being amended to make clear that we must still use that policy to exestigate in complaints of sexual harassment based on conduct alleged to ave occurred on or before July 31, 2024.
