David Courser Memorial Scholarship

David Courser was a student athlete at Bath High School, graduating in May of 1985. While a student at Bath, David participated in Track and Cross Country. After graduating, David attended Spring Arbor College while continuing his running career. He received a teaching degree in May of 1989. David passed away after being involved in an automobile accident shortly after graduating. To honor David's memory, the David Courser Memorial Relays Track Invitational and the David Courser Memorial Scholarship were established.

Scholarship Information and Criteria

In memory of David Courser, the Bath Athletic Boosters is offering a \$500 scholarship to a member of the Bath High School graduating class. This scholarship is restricted to graduates receiving their diploma from Bath High School.

The primary criteria for a recipient to qualify for this scholarship is either majoring in education at their chosen college or running cross country or track for at least two years in high school.

Guidelines

- 1. Applications will be available from Mrs. Fritz in the Bath High School Counseling Office.
- 2. Applicant must submit a scholarship application on or before Friday, April 26, 2024, to the HS Counselor's Office.
- 3. Applicant must submit at least one letter of recommendation.
- 4. Applicant must submit a short essay on "Why you want to become a teacher?" or "How running either cross country or track impacted your life."
- 5. The amount of the scholarship is \$500. Checks will be written to the recipient and the college/university of their choice.
- 6. The Scholarship Selections Committee (Bath Athletic Booster members) shall review all applications and reach a decision.
- 7. Recipient will be notified at the Senior Banquet.
