Reconfirmation Meeting for January

Reconfirm instructional delivery method:

Bath Community has moved all Y5's students through 12th grade students into a virtual setting through January 15th. Originally parents had the option of sending their students to a face-to-face learning environment or to have them in a virtual learning environment.

Y5's through 5th grade students are learning on a half day model with two groups of students. The morning group are those students who were previously face-to-face and the afternoon group are those that have been virtual the whole school year.

Parents will be surveyed as to their preference of virtual or face-to-face learning for the second semester the 2020-2021 school year.

The curriculum for each instructional model is aligned to the State mandated curriculum standards.

Per MiOSHA emergency guidelines state that staff who can complete their work from a remote site are required to do so with some exceptions. Those staff that cannot work remotely must fill out the appropriate paperwork. Staff that must report have been notified of their expectations.

Reconfirm how instruction will be delivered for each grade level:

Elementary (Grades Y5's - 5): Instruction will be all virtual for this age group. Fridays will be an asynchronous learning day for all students.

Reconfirm instructional delivery method:

Middle School (Grades 6 - 8): Instruction will be all virtual for this age group. Fridays will be an asynchronous learning day for all students.

High School (Grades 9 - 12): Instruction will be all virtual for this age group. Fridays will be an asynchronous learning day for all students.

Reconfirm whether or not the district is offering higher levels of in-person instruction for English language learners, special education students, or other special populations:

The district has worked with parents of special needs students to provide in person instruction even if an all virtual content delivery method was selected. ESL students will continue to receive instruction in the method that was selected.
