**Confirmation Meeting for July 26, 2021**

**Confirm instructional delivery method:**

Bath Community Schools will begin the 2021 – 2022 school year with in-person instruction 5 days a week. There will be options for those students who cannot attend in person due to a documented medical condition. Those options will be determined on a case by case basis and as needed.

Bath Community Schools will require at least the following COVID-19 measures for staff and all students beginning on August 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2021.

- Masks for staff and students will be **optional** for grades Y5's through 12<sup>th</sup> grade.
- Masks will be **required** on all school provided transportation for students and staff.
- Visitors will continue to be limited to those that are deemed essential such as substitute teachers.
- Students will be quarantined based on guidance and recommendations from the Mid-Michigan Health Department.
- Field trips will not be allowed at the start of the 21/22 school year. This will be reevaluated on a monthly basis.

**Confirm how instruction will be delivered for each grade level:**

Elementary (Grades Y5's - 5): Instruction will be in-person, five days a week and follow the published 2021 – 2022 school calendar. For those students with medical needs requiring non in-person instruction, a plan will be developed to accommodate their health needs.

Middle School (Grades 6 – 8): Instruction will be in-person, five days a week and follow the published 2021 – 2022 school calendar. For those students with medical needs requiring non in-person instruction, a plan will be developed to accommodate their health needs.

High School (Grades 9 – 12): Instruction will be in-person, five days a week and follow the published 2021 – 2022 school calendar. For those students with medical needs requiring non in-person instruction, a plan will be developed to accommodate their health needs.

**Reconfirm whether or not the district is offering higher levels of in-person instruction for English language learners, special education students, or other special populations:**

The district will be offering in-person instruction for all of our students grades Y5's through 12<sup>th</sup>. This will include all populations of students.
