Spring Break is approaching and we understand that while many will be staying in the area, there are also many who may travel over the break. The MDHHS along with Mid-Michigan District Health Department are utilizing the CDC guidelines for recommendations on how individuals should handle travel during the COVID-19 pandemic.

The CDC recommends that travel still be restricted to essential travel only. They do recognize though that there will be a number of people traveling in various methods. Travel on planes is deemed more risky than traveling by car with your family. The CDC recommends testing and quarantining upon returning from traveling.
