



Dear Scholarship Applicant,

It is a goal of the Clinton County Farm Bureau to support the industry of Agriculture, including the education of youth for future careers in our industry. Financial support for youth pursuing careers in agricultural related occupations should be a planned, annual effort of our organization. Therefore, the Clinton County Farm Bureau has developed the following scholarship program.

Eligibility:

- Youth must be pursuing a degree or certification in an agricultural related or adjacent field
- Youth must have a minimum of a 3.0 GPA
- Youth must possess the qualities of scholarship, leadership, and community service
- Youth must be entering their 1st or 2nd year of post high school study
- Applicant must be able to attend our County Annual Meeting on September 22nd, 2022 to accept the scholarship if they are chosen as a recipient

Award Procedures:

- A total scholarship fund of \$4,000 will be distributed among applicants deemed qualified by the Clinton County Farm Bureau Scholarship Committee
- Applications must be submitted by **April 1st, 2022**
- Applicants will be notified no later than May 16th, 2022 of their award status
- A scholarship check will be processed directly to the institution of study only after the submission of a paid registration receipt from an accredited institution
- Each scholarship recipient chosen will be granted a one-year regular membership into Clinton County Farm Bureau where they will be able to serve on the Young Farmer Committee
