Bath School Community,

We are planning on bringing our SECONDARY students back to school on Monday, October 26th. As a reminder, face masks are required for all students and staff. We will be limiting visitors to those entering for instructional purposes only, such as substitute teachers. We will use half day schedules for our secondary students as stated in our previous communications. **You can expect more building specific information including protocols and procedures by Monday, October 19th.** Also, as a reminder, those students who choose to remain online have committed to staying online through December 18th. Please know that we will continue to monitor and evaluate the health and safety of our students, staff and community. If the need arises—through consultation with the health department—we may need to change the format of our learning plans.

Those parents who have requested transportation will receive pick up and drop off times prior to the start of face-to-face learning. A lunch and a breakfast will be provided daily for secondary students who request them. Students will not be eating meals at school.
