### College Exploration Process

- > Be realistic
- ➤ Apply to 3+ schools
  - Safety School
  - o Match School
  - Reach School
- > Check school's deadlines
- > Rolling admissions (students are accepted throughout the year)
- Regular admissions (deadlines for certain colleges)
- > Early Action
- > Fee Waivers for application fee

## College Application Process

- > Online applications
- Counselor Pages- drop off to Mrs. Fritz to send
- > Transcripts- All Through Parchment!
  - o Link at bottom of HS web page
  - o Must request at time of application as well as for final grades
  - o Colleges and universities may recalculate your grade point using core classes.
  - o Will look at the rigor of the curriculum taken
  - o Should have at least 4-5 academic courses your senior year
  - O YOU will need to request for final transcripts to be sent! This will not automatic!!!!
  - o MSU rescinded admission to 50 students this year based on their final grades.
- > SAT or ACT Scores sent directly from College Board or ACT. Do this through your online account.
- > Teacher letters of recommendation- should come from teachers who taught subject matter in which you excelled. Recommendation form in google forms. Make copy and send to teachers.
- > If you haven't already, create a college application email address.
  - o Make sure to check this often. Many schools are communicating exclusively through the email address you provide.

### Writing Your Personal Statements and Essays

- > Read three different times by three different people
- ➢ Be Honest
- Let your voice be heard
- > If there is something about your record, explain it
- > Write about something that is important to you
- > Use language with which you are familiar
- > The essay should show your character and personality- not just bragging about your list of accomplishments.
- Answer the question when you choose a topic-follow directions, length and format
- Grammar and Spelling!
- Essays should tell the reader who you are and what you plan on bringing to enhance that schools campus.

# Financial Aid/Scholarships

- > FAFSA- completed ASAP beginning in October
- > Public vs. Private- \$\$\$\$
- > Some schools (i.e. GVSU) require applications in by November or December to qualify for scholarships.
- Scholarships
  - o Local, County, Region, State, National
  - Listen to announcements
  - o Check Counseling Website Often
  - o Remind
- > Students receiving Free and Reduced Lunch
  - o Application fee waivers/Test Waivers
  - o U of M
  - o TIP- may qualify even if do not receive Free and Reduced
